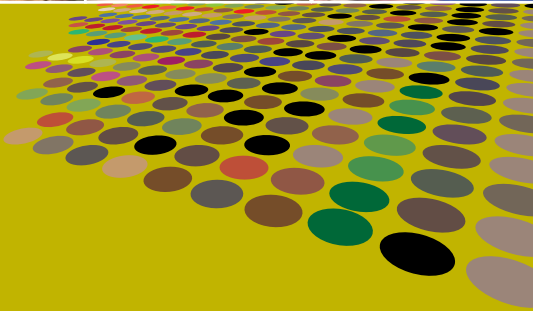


Skilling Queenslanders for work

Indigenous Employment and Training Managers

Skilling Queenslanders for Work is helping Indigenous Queenslanders get work and training to develop their local communities.



By working together Indigenous communities, other Indigenous organisations, government, industry and training organisations can identify, create and improve employment and training opportunities for local Indigenous people.

The Queensland Government employs Indigenous Employment and Training Managers (IETMs) to help make this happen.

IETMs help increase their community's capacity to:

- be involved in identifying and creating local employment and training opportunities
- liaise with key stakeholders in negotiating appropriate employment and training opportunities within priority target areas
- develop ways to respond to community needs and bring local employers, government and non-government agencies together to make the plans work.

They also:

- advise on how to better plan and coordinate employment and training activity associated with government building and civil construction projects in designated communities
- work with Indigenous Employment and Training Support Officers to maximise local Indigenous employment.
